## General Information

Welcome to Darjeeling Government College where academic excellence meets holistic development. We are delighted that you are considering joining our esteemed institution for your undergraduate studies. This prospectus serves as your guide to understanding our programs, admission procedures, campus facilities, and everything else you need to know to embark on an enriching educational journey with us.

Based on the details provided, it's crucial for prospective candidates to stay vigilant against potential scams promising admissions. These could come from private individuals, outsiders, or other external entities. It's important to emphasize that eligible students will only need to pay the specified admission and associated fees set by the college. The college won't demand any additional payments during the admission process.

Any candidate discovered violating the aforementioned regulations will lose their admission, even if it has already been formalized. In such cases, both the candidate and any individuals involved in such actions will face legal consequences as determined by the institution. It's advised that students avoid enrolling simultaneously in multiple institutions. If simultaneous admissions occur,-if students risk having their admissions revoked across all involved institutions, and their university registration may also be terminated.

## DARJEELING GOVERNMENT COLLEGE

Darjeeling Government College as it stands today since 5thAugust, 1948, has traversed a long way in serving the community. Darjeeling is very fortunate to have a government college of this stature and potentiality in this district town.

The college is situated at the foothills of the eastern sub-Himalayan region at an altitude of 2134 metres. It stands on the Lebong Cart Road near the Padmaja Naidu Himalayan Zoological Park and the Himalayan Mountaineering Institute. At the place where the college stands today in its full stature, previously stood St. Michael's School.

The full-time Government College teachers are appointed by the Government under the West Bengal Education Service (W.B.E.S.) \& W.B.S.E.S. on the basis of the recommendation of the Public Service Commission, West Bengal, following the eligibility criteria framed by the University Grants Commission (UGC). The college is a full-fledged Government college and is totally under the administrative control of the Higher Education Department (headed by the Principal Secretary, Government of West Bengal) that frames all the policies and modalities regarding the functioning of the college for the Principal to execute. The District Magistrate as the President of the Governing Body.

The college boasts of running the Indira Gandhi National Open University study centre since 1986; only one year after the University was established by the Central Government. Initially starting with 34 students, it now claims strength of 2500 and offers courses such as B.A., B.Com., M.A.(English, Hindi, History, Economics, Political Science, Public Administration, Rural Development, Sociology, Tourism Management and Commerce), certificate courses in Teaching of Primary School Mathematics, Diploma in Tourism Studies, English Teaching, selected Doctoral programme and so on.

One of the most important achievements of the college is the building up of a Central Library with a rich collection of more than $1,00,000$ books and good number of journals including rare volumes of Tibetan, Nepali and Sanskrit works. The students are allowed to borrow books for studying at home and are encouraged to use the reading room during the college hours. Honours and Post Graduate students enjoy an additional facility of using the extremely rich seminar libraries of their respective departments. The library keeps on adding to its existing resources by utilizing the annual grants provided by the Government and the UGC. The library also provides internet and e-journals (enlist inflibnet) facilities to the students.

In order to boost information intensive curriculum, most of the departments and offices are provided internet connections with WIFI (wireless fidelity) facility so that any student or teacher can avail unwired internet connection. The college is trying to introduce new subjects at the undergraduate level. The primary interest of Darjeeling Government College has always been to give maximum facility to its students. They are provided with a well-equipped cheap store and a cheap canteen. Three girls' hostels including a post graduate girls' hostel take care of the accommodation of out station students. Apart from keeping strict vigil on the academic performances of the students through regular internal tests, the college also emphasizes on their holistic development through encouragement of games and sports. A new fitness Centre has also been added to the college with the latest fitness equipments to cater to the physical fitness of the students as well as the teachers.

Cultural programmes are annually held and co-curricular activities such as quizzes, intercollege debates etc. are encouraged. The final year students are guided to make their future career plans through regular career counseling sessions. Along with holding social awareness programmes, the college tries to produce good citizens by providing N.C.C. training to its students. The college has one Company Senior Division NCC (boys) under 5 Bengal Boys Battalion NCC, Darjeeling, and two Platoon Senior Wing (girls) under 4 Bengal Girls Battalion NCC, Siliguri. Their training is managed by the Associate NCC Officers (ANO). The college N.C.C. Girls cadets have received prestigious awards like the Governor's medal, the Higher Education Minister's medal etc. The Girl Cadets of this college have represented the India Youth Exchange Programme in foreign countries like
U.K., Vietnam and Bangladesh. Some of the college cadets have also participated in the Republic Day parade in New Delhi and organised different courses of mountaineering, rock climbing, trekking, army attachments etc. The college is also proud of having a vibrant N.S.S. unit established in 2004. It has participated in social programmes organized by the Government and non-governmental organizations and also looks after the upkeep of the college.

The Teachers' Council is an academic body comprising of all the teachers of the college bounded by its constitution. The Teachers' Council gives advice to the Principal on different academic issues in relation to the college and different sub-committees regulate various activities of the college. The Council is headed by an elected General Secretary whose term in office is one year. Principal is the President of this Council.

Darjeeling Government College Alumni Association has been formed and is registered under West Bengal Societies Act.

Darjeeling Government College has already earned fame for encouraging academic intercourse through organizing national and international seminars and workshops on specific disciplines and interdisciplinary subjects. It is now on its way to inviting the NAAC visit and planning to further bolster students' welfare by organizing regular parent- teacher and alumni meets to get essential feedbacks about the functioning of the college.

From its day of inception to its journey till date, the college encountered many hurdles; but it has never stopped moving forward. Research projects sponsored by UGC, DST and other funding agencies are being carried out at the Doctoral levels. The college aims to become an affiliate of many other similar projects and has a vision to upgrade this institution to its zenith.

ADMISSION REGULATIONS W.E.F. 2024-2025 B.A./ B.COM./ B.SC. WITH SINGLE MAJOR \& SINGLE MINOR AND B.A./ B.COM./ B.SC) THREE DISCIPLINE SPECIFIC COURSES (MULTIDISCIPLINARY), 4-YEARS UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAM (FYUGP) UNDER THE NEW CURRICULUM AND CREDIT FRAMEWORK, 2022

## Admission Criteria

Every year, during the time well before the start of that year's fresh admission, the Criteria for Admission at Darjeeling Government College is framed in the meeting of corresponding year's Admission Committee of the college after consulting the published guidelines from Department of Higher Education, Science \& Technology and Biotechnology, Government of West Bengal and the University North Bengal. It is notified in the College website as well as in the college Notice-Board well before the admission.

## Academic Programs:

At Darjeeling Government College, we offer a diverse range of undergraduate programs across various disciplines, including:

- Arts and Humanities
- Sciences
- Commerce

Our comprehensive curriculum is designed to provide students with a well-rounded education, equipping them with the knowledge, skills, and perspectives necessary to thrive in their chosen fields and make meaningful contributions to society.

## I. Eligibility for Admission

## Single Major and Single Minor course: \% of Marks:

A student shall be allowed to take admission in the Single Major and Single Minor course of B.A. /B.Sc. /B.Com. if he/ she has passed in at least four (04) subjects with English as compulsory subject in the Higher Secondary [10+2] Examination held by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other Examination which is recognized by the University as equivalent thereto.

Provided that a candidate who has obtained- (a) $55 \%$ marks in the aggregate, or (b) $50 \%$ in the aggregate with $60 \%$ marks in a subject / related subject in the last qualifying Examination shall be eligible to apply for Single Major and Single Minor course in that subject.

Admission shall however be on merit and availability of seats.
Provided that for SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B/PWD candidates- the minimum marks for eligibility shall be as per Rules of the State Government.

Provided further that in matter of eligibility $54.5 \%$ marks or above shall be equal to $55 \%$, $49.5 \%$ and above shall be equal to $50 \%$ and 59.5 marks or above shall be equal to $60 \%$.

## II. Three Discipline Specific Courses (Multidisciplinary):

A student shall be allowed to take admission in the Multidisciplinary Course of B.A. /B.Sc. / B.Com / BBA/BCA/BBA (TAH) if he/ she has passed in at least four (04) subjects with English as compulsory subject in the Higher Secondary [10+2] Examination held by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other Examination which is recognized by the University as equivalent thereto.

A candidate shall be allowed to pursue B.A. / B. Sc. / B. Com / BBA / BCA / BBA (TAH) Multidisciplinary Course if he/ she has passed the qualifying Examination in Vocational Stream subjects. Such students shall have the option to study up to the end of 6th semester.

Choice of Major/Minor Courses for Single Major \& Single Minor and three Discipline specific Multidisciplinary courses:

- A student will be allowed to take up any subject except Computer Science/Microbiology and such other interdisciplinary subjects if he/she has passed in the said subject/related subject at the HS (10+2) examination or any other board recognized as equivalent by the University.
- A candidate will be allowed to take up Sociology or Psychology or Education or Mass Communication \& Journalism or BBA or BCA or BBA (TAH) if he/she has passed in the previous qualifying examination of any stream.
- A candidate will be allowed to take up B.Com. if he/she has studied Science subjects along with Mathematics in the previous qualifying exams.
- A candidate will be allowed to take up Physics Subject if he/she has passed in Mathematics and Chemistry along with Physics and other subject as prescribed at the qualifying examination.
- A candidate will be allowed to take up Chemistry Subject if he/she has passed in Mathematics and Physics along with Chemistry and other subject as prescribed at the qualifying examination.
- A candidate will be allowed to take up Botany/Zoology Subject if he/she has passed in Biology at the qualifying examination.
- A candidate will be allowed to take up Physiology subject if he/she has passed in Biology at the qualifying examination.
- A candidate will be allowed to take up Computer Science Subject if he/she has passed in Mathematics or Statistics at the qualifying examination.
- A candidate will be allowed to take up Microbiology Subject if he/she has passed in Chemistry and Biology at the qualifying Examination.
- A candidate will be allowed to take up Economics as if he/she has passed in Mathematics or Applied Mathematics or Business Economics including Business Mathematics, and other subjects as prescribed at the qualifying examination.
- A candidate will be allowed to take up Geography subject if he/she has passed in Geography at the qualifying examination.
- A candidate will be allowed to take up Geology subject if he/she has passed in Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry at the qualifying examination.
- A candidate pursuing Major in a subject will not be allowed to take up the same subject as Minor.
- While taking Major \& Minor subjects, availability of the said subjects in the concerned Colleges will be taken into cognizance.


## Merit Calculation

The merit point calculation is based on the directives of Department of Higher Education, Science \& Technology and Biotechnology, Government of West Bengal and University of North Bengal. It is notified in college Notice-Board and also in the College website.

For a Single Major and Single Minor course (4 year UG), where a student has studied the subject at +2 level $=($ Marks obtained in Major/ related subject + Marks obtained in English + Best marks obtained in other two subjects) / 4.

For a Single Major and Single Minor course (4 year UG), where a student has not studied the subject at +2 level $=($ Marks obtained in English + Best marks obtained in other three subjects) / 4 .

For a three discipline specific Multidisciplinary course $=$ (Marks obtained in English + Marks obtained in 3 Core / related subjects) /4.

## ADMISSION PROCEDURE:

As per guidelines of North Bengal University in compliance with W.B. Govt. Rules, provided that a student who has been admitted in the 1st Semester of an Academic year will not ordinarily require to take admission again on progressing to a subsequent Semester.

## FEES

As notified by the Higher Education Council/University Authority from time to time for Admissions, Registration and Examinations etc.

## ACADEMIC SESSION

a. The academic session normally will start in July in each year.
b. There will be at least 90 teaching days in each semester excluding periods of examination and admission etc. for instruction, field work and dissertation
c. The academic sessions including the examinations for first, third, fifth and seventh semester are July to December and that for second, fourth, sixth and eighth semester are January to June.

## OTHER REGULATIONS

Reservation of Seats: There will be reservation of seats for SC/ST/OBC/EWS/DifferentlyAbled Candidates as per Government Rules. For differently-abled candidates' minimum disability at least $40 \%$ will be considered.

Session Gap: For admission to the Undergraduate Program there should not be a gap of more than 3 years between the year of Higher Secondary Examination and the year of admission to Undergraduate Program of study.

Session Break: Students who exit with Undergraduate Certificate or Undergraduate Diploma, are permitted to re-enter within 3 (three) years and complete the Degree Program Students are also permitted to take a break from the study, during the period of study, but the total duration for completing the program will not exceed seven years.

Admission on Transfer: If a student has been admitted to a College, he/she/transgender will not, except as otherwise provided in the Ordinances, be subsequently admitted to any other College without the production of a Transfer Certificate from the Principal of the College in which he/she/transgender studied last.

A student admitted to a College, will not ordinarily be allowed to take transfer to any other College, except at the end of a semester. If an application for transfer is made at any time, other than at the end of a Semester, on the ground of (a) transfer of the parent / guardian of the student from the station at which the College is situated, or (b) reasoned need for a change on the ground of health supported by proper medical evidence, or any other sufficient reason, the Principal may grant the transfer.

A student may apply for transfer within one month from the date of publication of semester-end examination and the student should qualify all the previous semester examinations without any back paper(s).

## Admission on Transfer should abide by the following stipulations:

A candidate taking transfer from one College to another is required to pursue the same set of courses of study in both the colleges;
a. Admission on transfer must not violate the approved intake of the course concerned of the College granting admission. Only in cases of wards of Government employees who have been transferred, a relaxation of intake may be granted with the permission of the ViceChancellor;
b. Cases of admission on transfer must be intimated in writing to the University authority by the College admitting such candidates within a fortnight of such admission without which such admission on transfer will not be recognized;
c. All other steps and procedures related to transfer will be in accordance with the provisions of the Ordinances.

## TERMINATION

If a student newly admitted to the first semester remains absent from attending classes for more than the first 15 days continuously without any intimation, his/her/transgender admission will stand cancelled.

COMPLETION OF UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMMES OF THE UNIVERSITY

- A 3-year undergraduate programme has to be completed within a span of 5-year from the year of admission.
- A 4-year undergraduate programme has to be completed within a span of 7-year from the year of admission.
